

Instructions for Hardrock Polishing Cream PC7032

EQUIPMENT NEEDED TO POLISH FLOORS

1. Floor buffing machine 175-350RPM.
2. **Hardrock Polishing Cream.**
3. White buffing pad.
4. Spray bottle containing water.

POLISHING THE FLOOR

1. Clean/Strip the floor as needed to remove any dirt or wax.
2. Shake the **Hardrock Polishing Cream** before using and apply 3-4 tablespoons and 2-4 squirts of water on the floor in a circle approximately the same size as the buffing pad.
3. Place the buffing pad and machine on top of the **Hardrock Polishing Cream** on the floor.
4. Start buffing the cream in a 3'X3' area. Add polishing cream or water as necessary while buffing to maintain light slurry on the floor. Stop and check the floor periodically to see if desired shine has been achieved.
5. Once desired shine has been achieved, mop area to remove any excess polish residue.

POLISHING COUNTERTOPS, TABLES AND VANITIES

1. Follow the instructions for polishing floors except use less polishing cream and a hand held buffer.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE BY HAND

Supplies Needed:

1. Terry cloth or soft rag for polishing.
2. Spray bottle of water.
3. Towel or soft cloth for drying.

APPLICATION

1. Place about one tablespoon of **Hardrock Polishing Cream** and water on the area to be polished.
2. Buff with the polishing cloth until the Cream becomes clear and almost dry.
3. Add more water to re-wet the area and then dry completely.
4. Repeat as needed to produce the desired shine.

SAMPLE TESTING: Before using, always test each surface to be treated in a small inconspicuous area to insure the desired results will be achieved. Consult supplier for further information and precautions, including Material Safety Data Sheets.

POISON: Contains Potassium Oxalate.

Eye irritant. Avoid contact with eyes and skin.

FIRST AID: SKIN: Wash with soap and water. If irritation persists, call physician. **EYES:** Flush with water for 15 minutes. Call physician. **INGESTION:** Drink large amounts of water and induce vomiting. Call a physician.

INHALATION: Get person to fresh air. If unconscious, call a physician.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Rinse three times with water. Then offer for recycling, reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay away from smoke.
