

Instructions for Hardrock Phosphoric Acid Cleaner PAC6000

HARDROCK PHOSPHORIC ACID CLEANER is a concentrated, high strength, acid based cleaner.

USES: For cleaning grout and removing grout smears, harmful fumes may result. efflorescence, rust, hard water, lime, scale, and other mineral deposits from acid resistant tile, porcelain, ceramic, granite, masonry, and unpolished stone.

PREPARATION: Wait a minimum of 7 days before cleaning newly grouted installations. Mask off any adjoining surfaces that may be damaged by acid. Use plastic or acid resistant tape.

Test a small area before complete application to insure the desired results will be achieved.

MIXING: The ratio of acid to water will vary depending on the job to be done. Start with a mix of 1 part acid to 5 parts water and adjust the strength as needed.

APPLICATION: Pre-wet the surface with a light amount of water, apply the mixed acid solution and allow to stand for 1 or 2 minutes and then agitate with a brush or white scrub pad. Do not allow the solution to dry on the surface. Vacuum or mop up the dirty solution. Re-wet with clean water and scrub with a brush or white pad and rinse thoroughly to insure that all of the acid solution has been removed.

COVERAGE: Depending on the application, one gallon (3.78 L) will clean from 250 to 1500 square feet (23 to 139 square meters).

MAINTENANCE: Hardrock Stone & Tile Cleaner is recommended for regular maintenance cleaning.

LIMITATIONS: Not for use on polished marble or other acid sensitive stone. May etch or lighten the color of cement based materials. Do not mix with ammoniated cleaners as harmful fumes may result.

SAMPLE TESTING: Before using, always test each surface to be treated in a small inconspicuous area to insure the desired results will be achieved. Consult supplier for further information and precautions, including Material Safety Data Sheets.

Note: Do not place container on formica, or any other porous surfaces.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Rinse three times with water. Then offer for recycling, reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities by burning. If burned, stay away from smoke.

WARNING: Contains phosphoric acid. In case of external contact, flush with cool water. If irritation persists, contact a physician. For eyes, flush with water and get medical attention. If swallowed, give large amounts of water to dilute, followed by milk of magnesia. Call physician. For inhalation, get person to fresh air. Container Disposal: Rinse three times with water. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill (dump), or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay away from smoke.

Keep out of reach of children.
