

Instructions for Hardrock Stone & Tile Cleaner STC4000

HARDROCK STONE & TILE CLEANER is a super concentrated, powerful, no rinse neutral cleaner that will safely remove heel marks, surface soil, and dust from any surface. It contains the latest development in optical brighteners that will substantially enhance shiny appearance of the surface.

USES: For frequent damp mopping and cleaning of any hard, glossy surface. Use on both natural or waxed surfaces.

PREPARATION: Dust mop, sweep or vacuum area to remove loose dirt. Test a small area before complete application to insure the desired results will be achieved.

APPLICATION: Mix 3 oz. (90 ml) of cleaner per one gallon (3.785 L) of water. For floors: Ring excess liquid from the mop and damp mop the floor. Allow to air dry. Do not rinse. For counter tops and walls wipe with a cloth or sponge containing the mixed solution.

COVERAGE: One gallon (3.78 L) will clean from 20,000 to 30,000 square feet (1860 to 2790 square meters).

LIMITATIONS: None

FIRST AID
